

KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Vice Admiral William "Andy" Brown, USN (Ret.), retired in November 2017 after nearly 38 years of naval service. During his long and distinguished career, he held several demanding positions including Director for Logistics (J4) on the Joint Staff, Deputy Commander of the U.S. Transportation Command, Scott Air Force Base, and Director of Logistics (J4) at U.S. European Command in Stuttgart, Germany, to name a few.

Admiral Brown was named to be the President and CEO, National Defense Transportation Association, in November 2017, where he continues to serve.

Admiral Brown will deliver the lunch keynote and address the topic of *Preparedness and Partnership: Leveraging the Nation's Resources to Support Contingency Operations.*




VADM William A. Brown, USN (Ret.), NDTA President and CEO 2017-

Dr. Richard Strand is currently serving as the Principal and Owner of Richard & Associates, working primarily to develop the leadership talent and educational programs connected to aerospace, advanced manufacturing, and higher education.

During his 30 years of active service in the US Army, he commanded organizations from Company through Brigade-level, in addition to being assigned to prominent staff positions in the Director of Logistics office, the Joint Staff, Pentagon, the Director of Logistics office, HQS US Army Europe, and as Special Assistant to the Supreme Allied Commander Europe.

He has also had a long and distinguished academic career as a professor at the National Defense University, Washington DC and as a college administrator and executive.

Dr. Strand will address two topics during the Academy, including a keynote presentation addressing the major *Strategic issues and concerns that confront the Nation*, and a concurrent session dedicated to *Understanding Ukraine*.
